Introduction

Nihonmatsu Training Center (NTC) was established in 1994 in the city of Nihonmatsu (Nihonmatsu), Fukushima prefecture located about 250km north-northeast of Tokyo. Nihonmatsu is one of historical cities in Fukushima with a castle built more than 400 years ago. NTC stands halfway up a volcano, Mt. Adatarata.

Main function of NTC is to offer language training and other necessary subjects to the candidates to be dispatched to developing countries in the scheme of JICA's volunteer programs. For these twenty years NTC has sent out more than 10,000 (Ten Thousand) volunteers.

Besides this, NTC is functioning as a coordinator to facilitate linkage between Fukushima with rich and experienced resources and developing countries through JICA Partnership Program or Training Program for Youth Leaders.
